



Sponsor and Program Insights

During C4 2018, there were 24 public non-traded REITs (NTRs) actively raising capital (open NTRs) and 41 NTRs that are closed but have not yet liquidated (closed NTRs). Nine programs operatins closed in 2018, including four in C4, with only four new programs operating the year. Griffin Capital Essential Asset REIT. Two sponsors, Lightstone Capital Essential Asset REIT is uspended its offering pending a merger with Griffin Capital Essential Asset REIT. Two sponsors, Lightstone Capital and MVP Capital, decided to leave the NTR market attogether. Liquidity events included five mergers, four completed assets asiles, and only one listing on a public eventage. American Finance Trust, inc. (formerly American Realty Capital Trust V, Inc.) listed on July 19, 2018, at \$15.00 per share. The stock declined 8.62% after its listing in 2018, roughly in-line with its Diversified category peers. As of March 31, 2019, AFIN has declined 17.03% YTD compared to positive 13.76% for its peer group average. NAREIT reported that there were only five IPOs in the traded REIT market in 2018, one of the lowest numbers over the last decade and roughly a quarter of the 19 IPOs in 2013. Continued discounts to private market proses for public REITs could lead to further M&A and sales as opposed to Isings for 2019 liquidity events.

Active programs raised \$4.7 billion in 2018, the highest amount since 2015. Closed programs raised \$889.9 million through distribution reinvestment programs. While fundraising across the industry has picked up, it has also become more concentrated in the top sponsor. Blackstone increased its leader-ship position to 63% of capital raised by active sponsors in 2018, up from 47% in 2017. Perpetual life NTRs represented approximately 82% of the capital raised YTD (which includes Blackstone), and the industry remains focused on core real estate strategies at nearly 90% of capital raised.
